

Report on “Interactive Action- Driven Session on Plastic Waste Management”- A GUEST LECTURE

The Green Campus Program Committee of BVC organised a Guest Lecture for the students on 24-02-2023 at 2PM in Seminar Hall, MBA Block. The speaker was Ms. Damini Malhotra from Recykal Foundation. The topic of the lecture was **Interactive Action- Driven Session on Plastic Waste Management**. The lecture was attended by Principal Dr. GSVRK Choudhary, Mrs. B. Niraimathi, IQAC coordinator, BVC, Faculty. students of all faculties and NCC etc. The Lecturer coordinators for this event were Dr Y Aparna & M D Kaleem Ullah.

The Program began by an address by Dr GSVRK Choudhary, Principal, BVC He urged on the need of recycling. Ms Malhotra, the Guest speaker enlightened the students on plastic management. Proper management of plastic garbage was the emphasis of this session. Information was given regarding the overuse of plastic, its varieties or types, its codes and the 5Rs. The speaker spoke in depth on how Government has formed certain guidelines for treatment of plastic EPR and E-waste. The guest speaker gave a comprehensive explanation of the topic through a PowerPoint presentation. The talk ended with an interactive question and answer session. The speaker awarded points for every right answer given by the students. The participants were asked to explain their plans for future plastic waste collection drives. It was an enriching session where participants were informed about different ways to manage plastic usage. 124 students from various faculties of our college participated in the guest lecture.

REPORT ON GUEST LECTURE

A Guest lecture was conducted by the Green Campus Program, of our college, on 08-02-2023 from 11:00 am to 12:00 noon in room no. 71, Biochemistry Block. The Resource Person was Mr. S Sundara Moorthy. .”. He is an independent consultant associated with manufacturing industries, recyclers, USAID funded projects and assisting them in fulfilling policy advocacy, regulatory compliances and environmental awareness programs. He is a Certified Energy Auditor and previously worked with Bureau of Energy Efficiency (under Govt. of India), CLASP and Panasonic Life Solutions Pvt Ltd. The topic of the lecture was “E- Waste Management and Environmental Awareness”. Students from Life sciences, Physical Sciences and Commerce along with NCC, NSS, BSG and YRC attended the lecture. Total of around 118 participants. Dr. GSVRK Choudhary, Principal, BVC and members of GCP attended the program.

Mr. Moorthy spoke in detail about Nature, Ecosystem and Environment. Current environmental issues like Climate Change, Environmental Health and Resource Depletion were also discussed in the lecture. He informed that the world’s target temperature is to reduce 1.5°C and for India it is 3°C by the year 2030. The goal of “Panchamrit”, a commitment to reach net- zero carbon emission by 2070 in India. He informed that there are various Acts and Rules implemented by the Indian Constitution for protection of our country’s Ecosystem and Environment. Recycling of E- waste under the guidelines of Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) of India was also discussed in the lecture. Students felt that the session was informative.

Dr Choudhary, Principal, BVC, in his address to the students emphasized the need to have a plastic free life. He also informed that steps are to be taken to make college campus one time use plastic free.



Prof Y Ashok, Principal, BVC, welcomed the guests in his address. He appreciated Sadguru for taking up initiative of saving soil. He informed that world will face disaster if soil is not conserved. He urged the students to watch Sadguru's videos. Mr Arun Kumar while addressing the audience informed that 'Save Soil' is one of the biggest movements on soil awareness, He told that the present organic content of soil is less than 0.5% and soil is decertified. He urged the students to spend 5 minutes every day on social media for saving soil.
