2019-20	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Initiative was taken by the Career Guidance and Placement Cell to conduct Placement Eligibility Test and guest lectures/seminars on 'Overseas education'. ✓ It was decided that all the departments should offer at least one certificate course, each. ✓ A new programme, B.Com. Honours (Business Analytics), has been proposed in lieu of one section of B.Com. (Reg.), from the academic year 2019-20 (as per the Academic Council meeting in May 2019). ✓ It was decided that online MOOC courses should be made compulsory for UG (HBA & BCA-3rd Semester) and PG (3rd Semester) students. ✓ New programmes and programmes with change of optional subjects/courses were finalized for the next academic session, i.e, 2020-21 – B.Sc. (Microbiology, Nutrition & Dietetics and Chemistry) & B.Sc. (Honours) (Data Science). ✓ As suggested by the IQAC, proposals for starting Ph.D. programs were submitted by the Departments of Commerce and Management Studies. ✓ It was decided that the Department of Languages in collaboration with the NSS unit of the college should conduct an outreach programme, at a Government school, comprising an interactive session in English. ✓ An initiative was taken to promote research environment in the campus by making it imperative for at least 40% of the staff members to publish their research papers in UGC CARE journals. ✓ It was decided that guest lectures/seminars/workshops would be organised by all the departments for quality enhancement and reinforcement of pedagogy and learning. ✓ Initiative was taken to celebrate the 150th Birth Anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi by conducting various literary and cultural programmes, with the motto of reviving the Gandhian values and reiterating his legacy. ✓ It was decided that the Medical and Health Committee would organize health camps to promote health care and monitor various health parameters of faculty members and students. ✓ It was resolved that the ED cell would organize training programmes/seminars to enhance entrepreneurial skills, promote start-ups and guide students in launching them.

- ✓ All the Science departments of the college resolved to conduct seminars, workshops and intercollegiate competitions as part of National Science Day celebrations.
- ✓ It was resolved that the SSR should be prepared for submission in December 2020.
- ✓ Initiative was taken to augment the infrastructure of the MBA block by building six rooms and washrooms to facilitate additional accommodation and installing a lift.
- ✓ Initiative was taken to include practical components in Mass Communication and Journalism from the academic year 2020-21.
- ✓ The NSS unit initiated to enroll for Unnat Bharath Abhiyan, a flagship programme of MHRD, Government of India to involve higher education institutions of the country for indigenous development of self-sufficient and sustainable village clusters for inclusive India.
