Existing Pattern of CIA:

CIA-I: 25 Marks (Objective + Descriptive)

CIA-II: 25 Marks (Descriptive)

Assignment: 5 Marks

Total: 30 Marks (Average of (CIA-I+CIA-II) + Assignment)

Revised Pattern of CIA:

CIA-I: 15 Marks Online Examination (30 Objective - 30 Mins)

CIA-II: 30 Marks (1 Hour) - Totally Descriptive

Attendance: 7 Marks

Assignment/Quiz/Class room participations/Seminars etc.: 8 Marks

Total: 30 Marks = Average of (CIA-I (15) + CIA-II (30) + Attendance (7) + Assignments (8)

It was resolved that in the next meeting of the Heads of the Departments, which will be conducted shortly, the method of conducting CIA exam will be discussed and decided.

Item 2: Proposal for entrance examination in select programmes
