- (1) Every cadets participating in various centrally organised selection camps like (RDC, YEP,TSC, National Sports, Mavlankar shooting championship, MT Everest) are felicitated by the college with a cash award along with a memento and an appreciation certificate on Annual Day Celebration.
- (2) Track Suits to the achievers and participants of centrally organised selection based camps such as RDC, TSC, and IDSSC etc.
